

## Beaumont Skating Club

### Policies, Terms and Conditions

#### 2016/2017 Season

**By Clicking Agree – you agree to all Policies, Terms and Conditions of the Beaumont Skating Club.**

#### **Registration:**

- All Registrations are on a first come, first serve basis.
- Registrations will be confirmed by Club E-mail once registration payment and Fundraising/Volunteer Commitments have been received.
- It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure that all necessary emergency information (i.e. medical and/or special needs) has been disclosed. We encourage parents to speak with coaches prior to the start of the program.
- Intro to Figure Skating/Senior Skaters – It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure they have discussed lesson plans with coaches. The Club has no involvement with private or semi-private lessons.
- It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure we have all the correct contact information including all e-mail addresses as that is our primary form of communication with our families.

#### **FUNDRAISING & VOLUNTEER PAYMENTS**

Effective August 1, 2016, the Beaumont Skating Club will no longer be accepting cheques to be held in trust for Fundraising/Volunteer Commitments. Instead, those that do not choose to pay out their commitment or complete their commitment will be invoiced and charged by the Club through the registration system (RAMP).

Before registration can be confirmed Registrants will be given two options. They are:

1. Registrants will have the option to **pay out** these commitments at the time of registration. If paid out, no volunteer and/or fundraising commitment will be needed to be done.
2. If they choose **not to pay out** their options they will be contacted by Executive to provide their choice to Fundraising/Volunteer Commitment (which ever is required). Registration will be confirmed once their choice of commitment(s) is made. They will be sent e-mail confirmation of registration from the BSC Club.

Invoice and Charges will be applied if their commitments are not met as agreed upon. Registrants will be given notice of when and where the commitment will be required to be fulfilled. The Registrant will be required to notify the Event Coordinator to advise if they are not able to fulfill their commitment prior to the commitment starting. *For example, if the Registrant cannot have the PreCS and CS equipment out before 5:15pm on Tues/Thurs they will be required to notify the Event Coordinator 6 hours prior to. Failure to notify the Event Coordinator will mean that they will be invoiced for their commitment.*

See details of each commitment needing to be filled for specific details on the Club Website.

By Clicking Submit Registration on the Terms and Conditions within the online registration system, you are agreeing to abide by and allow the Club to Invoice/Charge your credit card if you do not complete your commitment as you agreed to.

- If the choice to opt out of Fundraising &/Or Volunteer Commitment is made, please note that payment is required at the time of registration (online at time of checkout).
- If not opting out, it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to pick up fundraising components for the year OR to register for the volunteer commitment (first come first serve). The Club will notify via e-mail and website when items are available. If you are unable to complete fundraising on the allocated date(s) and time(s) then it is the parent's responsibility to make arrangements for drop off on the specified dates etc or your RAMP account will be invoiced. If you are unable to complete the volunteer commitment as selected and adequate notice is not given, then you will be charged for your volunteer commitment.

### Equipment:

- All **PreCanSkate, CanSkaters and Power Skaters MUST** wear a CSA approved protective headgear designed specifically for skating. Face shields are highly encouraged. Please note, bike helmets will not be accepted and if worn, your child will not be allowed to skate.
- All **PreCanSkaters and CanSkaters** are to be in comfortable and warm clothing. This includes mitts/gloves. Layering is best with splash pants over top so they do not get wet and cold.

- **PowerSkaters** are required to be in full hockey/ringette gear including helmet and stick
- **Intro to Figure Skating and Senior Skaters** are required to wear proper figure skating attire; this includes skating dresses with tights, shorts with tights, leggings with light jacket (no hoods). No Jeans.
- Skates are to be worn on the ice at all times. No boots, shoes or bob skates. It is recommended that skaters/parents read the "How to Fit Skates" that is posted on our website to ensure skaters have the correct skates.

#### **Club Rules & Conduct:**

- Parents/Guardians and Skaters are required to read and comply with the Club Rules and Conduct. This includes Parent and Skater Conduct as per Skate Canada. This is found on the Club Website.

#### **Class Cancellations & Make Up Classes:**

- Make-up classes will not be offered as a result of rain, snow or other inclement weather.
- Make-up Classes will not be offered as a result of personal illness or scheduling conflicts.
- Beaumont Skating Club reserves the right to cancel any program due to insufficient enrollment. Upon cancellation a full refund will be made.
- Intro to Figure Skating and Senior Skaters must provide absence notification to their coach by no later than 12 noon the day of their lesson or they will be charged for the missed lesson.

#### **Beaumont Skating Club Refund Policy - no Exceptions**

Payment will be accepted only at the time of registration. No exceptions. PLEASE NOTE: It is the skater's responsibility to notify the Registrar at [BSCRegistrar@outlook.com](mailto:BSCRegistrar@outlook.com) of any withdrawals.

Fall and Winter Registration Deadline: 7 days prior to the program skate date, a full refund will be issued.

Later than 7 Days Prior To & After Start Date: Should a skater wish to withdraw between 7 days prior to OR after the start date the deadline is:

**IFS & StarSkaters** - September 19, 2016

**Tues/Thurs & Thursday Only PreCanSkate & CanSkate** - September 28, 2016 (fall sessions) and  
January 16, 2017 (Winter session)

**Tuesday Only PreCanSkate & CanSkate** - October 3, 2016 (fall Session)  
- January 16, 2017 (winter session)

The \$25 Refund Administration Fee, BSC Administration fee (if applicable) and \$40 Skate Canada Membership will be charged and a refund for the pro-rated remainder of the season will be issued.

After the Deadline Date: NO REFUNDS will be issued (this includes Fundraising and Volunteering)

**PowerSkating Refund Deadline:** 7 days prior to the program skate date, a full refund will be issued. Withdrawals that occur BEFORE the 2nd class will incur a \$25 Refund Administration Fee as well as the \$40 BSC Administration and a refund for the remaining will be issued. After that date, NO REFUNDS will be issued.

### **Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) & Administration Fees:**

- The Club imposes a \$25 NSF fee on all cheques returned back to the club.
- All Registration Refunds will have a \$25 Administration Fee imposed on them.

### **E-mail Policy:**

In an effort to be environmentally friendly and to save money, the Beaumont Skating Club's primary form of communication with skaters and parents will be via e-mail. We request a valid e-mail address so that we may contact you and keep you informed throughout the year. By agreeing to the Policies, Terms and Conditions, you agree to allow us to e-mail you to keep you updated on the Club's happenings.

### **Privacy Policy:**

- All family personal information is processed and stored in a secure database with access controls.
- We use this information for statistical analysis to develop programs required for the future.
- We do not sell or rent your family information to any person or organization. Information is only given to those directly involved with Club in providing a service to your child or as required by law. Forms are destroyed at the end of each season.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **1. Acceptance of Terms and Conditions**

In consideration of your use of the Beaumont Skating Club services, you hereby agree that the services are provided to you under the following Terms and Conditions, which may be updated by us from time to time without notice to you.

### **2. Description Of Service**

As used in this agreement, services means the online services provided by Beaumont Skating Club. The services currently include providing users with access to information regarding various programs, camps and other events, plus the ability to register and pay for the program online. As used in this agreement, (registrant) means the person designated to participate in the event.

### **3. Minimum Age; Parent Or Guardian**

By using this service you certify that you are at least 18 years old. If the person who you are registering for an event is less than 18 years old, you certify that you are the parent or legal guardian of the registrant.

### **4. Privacy Policy**

You agree to provide true, accurate, current and complete information when such information is requested in connection with a program. Information you provide is subject to our Privacy Policy, which we encourage you to read above.

### **5. Release and Indemnity**

On behalf of yourself, the registrant, and the registrants parents or guardians, you hereby release and discharge Beaumont Skating Club and the Related Parties listed below from all claims made on behalf of yourself, the

registrant, and the registrants parents or guardians (and the executors, heirs, administrators, and assigns of all such parties) against all claims, demands, judgments, and costs (including reasonable attorney's fees) arising out of or relating to the registrants participation in a program. Further, you agree to indemnify and hold Beaumont Skating Club and the Related Parties harmless from all such claims, demands, judgments, and costs (including reasonable attorney's fees) made by any third party arising out of or relating to the registrants participation in an event. For purpose of this section, (Related Parties) means Beaumont Skating Club and its directors, officers, agents, coaches, and affiliates and other partners.

#### **6. Limitation of Liability**

Beaumont Skating Club shall not in any way be responsible for loss of property, damage or injuries to person, however caused, including participants while on the premises of the Ken Nichol Regional Recreation Centre.

#### **Waiver & Release**

**I have read and understood the Policies, Terms and Conditions in its entirety including the Club Rules and Conduct.** It is understood and agreed, as a condition of participation in skating offered by the Beaumont Skating Club and Skate Canada, that neither the Club nor Skate Canada shall be liable for any injury, loss or damage suffered by the above-noted member while traveling to or from, or while participating in skating practices, competitions or other activities, however caused. It is further agreed that neither the Club nor Skate Canada is responsible for any injury, loss or damage caused by the member while traveling to or from, or while participating in the said practices, competitions, or other activities. The member, or his/her parent/legal guardian, shall indemnify the Beaumont Skating Club and Skate Canada, and hold them harmless from any claims, demands or actions arising from, or in respect of such injury, loss or damage.
