Hockey Inspired CanSkate

Ideal for skaters that are 5-15 years of age OR have completed the Pre-CanSkate program. Kids are encouraged to wear their favorite jersey and hockey/ringette gloves, and bring their stick. This program builds on the fundamental movements of skating through an interactive group lesson format. The "Hockey Inspired" CanSkate program will prepare skaters for recreational skating, hockey or ringette.

This program was developed to allow a family member to assist in their young skaters development. This program allows the skaters to receive hands-on assistance from a family member who they know, trust and is in their cohort.

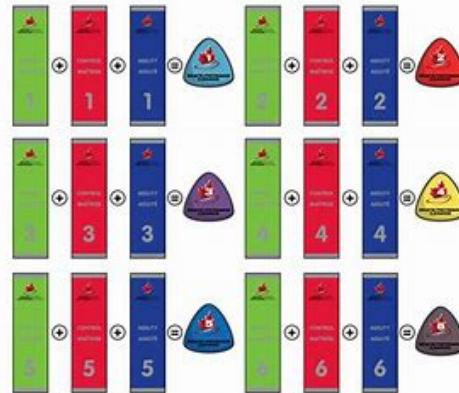
COMPETITIONS

Unfortunately, BSC will not be able to participate in out of house competitions this year as per Skate AB/NWT/NUN Covid-19 Protocols. We are still hopeful to hold our in-house Sk8t Gr8t showcase in March 2021.

CANSKATE COLOURS, RIBBONS AND BADGES

We often get questions about the colors for the groups after the first class. The colors are just a means of making groups. Some skating skills are taken into consideration along with age when creating the skater groups. Evaluations are done weekly so movement into another group may occur at any time.

Skaters in CanSkate will receive a Stage badge once they have achieved all three of the fundamental movements in their Stage. The fundamental movements are: Balance (green), Agility (blue) and Control (red). If only one or two fundamental movements are achieved, skaters will receive a ribbon. There are six Stages.



REPORT CARDS
CanSkate Report Cards will be emailed home at the end of the Fall session

A complete series of balance, control and agility skills are taught in six stages of learning that pertain to hockey, ringette, speed skating and figure skating as well as general recreational skating. Nationally-tested and proven curriculum and delivery methods that guarantee skater success in developing stronger basic skills and developing them faster.

EQUIPMENT:

Please ensure your skater has the proper attire and equipment while on the ice:

- No fuzzy gloves, as they stick to the ice and create a hazard
- Skates sharpened regularly
- No restrictive clothes such as tight pants or hockey gear
- Helmets for CanSkate and IFS skaters
- Skates that are fitted properly. Skates that are too big can make skating difficult
- Molded or plastic skates do not provide the same support and control and can make learner to skate more difficult
